



# How to access TutorMe




## 1. Login to Blackboard.

Select the class you want tutoring for.




## 2. Select "Tools" From Navigation Menu.

### 3. From the "Tools" page select TutorMe.





### 4. Make sure you are logged in on the TutorMe site.


