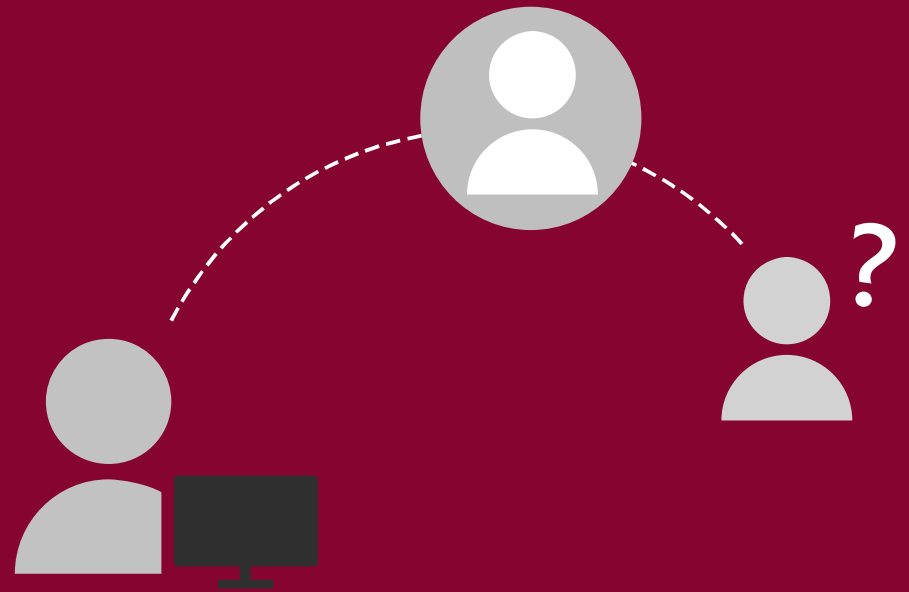
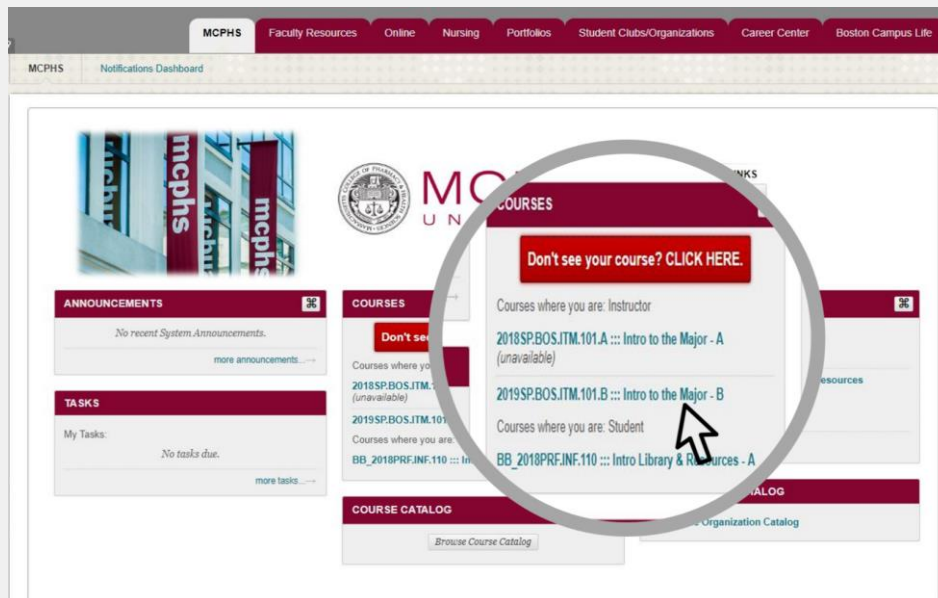


How to access TutorMe

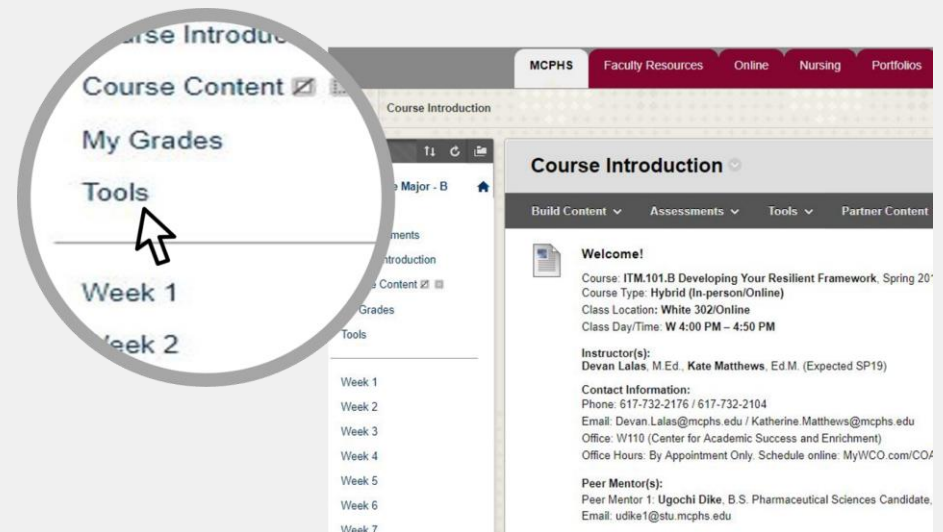


1. Login to Blackboard.

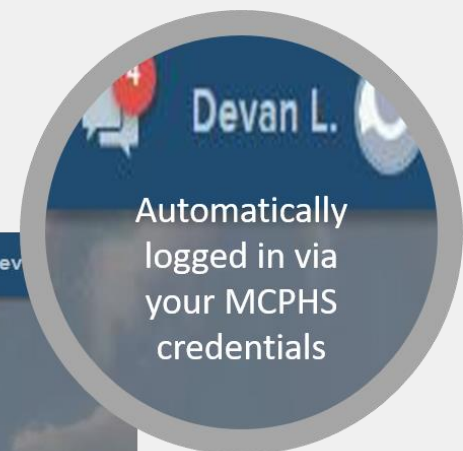

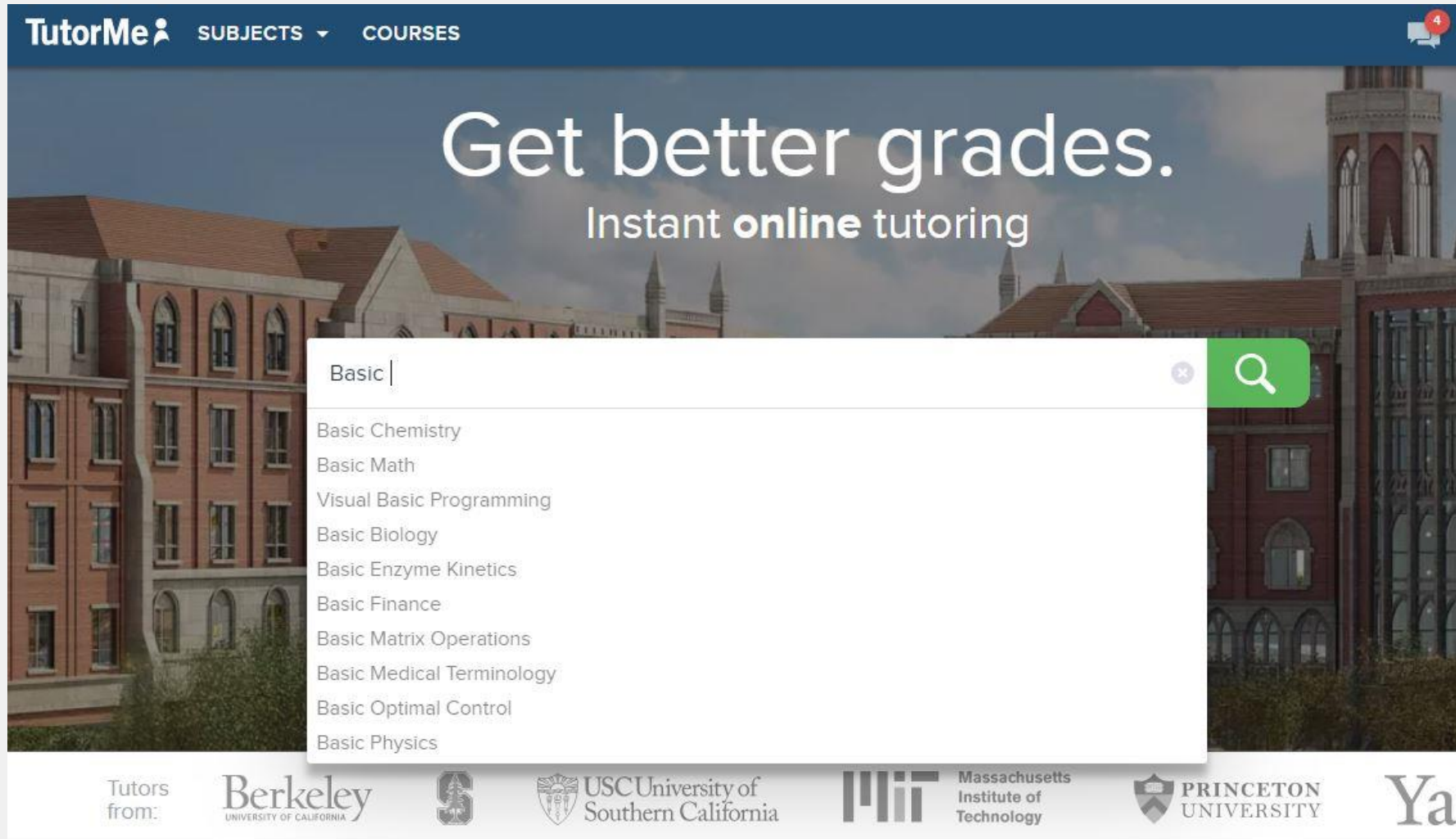
Selecting **TutorMe** via the Tools in Blackboard will automatically log you into TutorMe with your MCPHS credentials.
